STORYBUS VISITS PRE-1A AND 1ST GRADE

There was much excitement as the Dolores Kohl Education Foundation StoryBus pulled into our schoolyard this past Wednesday afternoon! The StoryBus is not like a library bus filled with books, it's a recreational vehicle (RV) transformed into a story! As each of the Pre-1A and 1st grade classes entered the "bus," the boys were transported into the story of The Little Red Hen. Miss Nancy, the storyteller and driver of the bus, told the story of The Little Red Hen using puppets and props. Through the story the boys learned about the process of harvesting, which our boys knew so well thanks to their Pre-1A Rebbeim's teachings on Hilchos Shabbos! Miss Nancy also emphasized how working together and helping others makes a job easier and more fun just as Little Red Hen's friends learned too!

After the dramatic story telling, the boys were able to play at different stations in the bus. There was an apple tree where the boys could "pick" the wooden apples and place them on a hand-cranked conveyer belt; there was a threshing mill which simulated turning wheat into flour; a pretend vegetable garden; stuffed animals and puppets; a large kitchen play area; a fishing pond with fishing poles; a mailbox filled with mail; and other hands-on, manipulative activities including an old-fashioned telephone (that you have to actually dial)!



K JOURNEYS READING PROGRAM IN THE KINDERGARTEN

The Kindergarten girls in room 126 have been having a lot of fun learning how to read using our brand new Journeys reading program. We have learned to read, spell, and write 12 new sight words and 7 new letters! We've been working on blending CVC words and can already write in full sentences using our sight words and CVC words! We practice spelling and writing our new words by making them out of play dough, writing them in the sand box, and using ABC patterning cubes. The girls look forward to learning the new letter and sight words every week and can't wait to continue working on their reading and writing skills.

The Language Arts program allows the girls to enrich their reading comprehension by reading weekly stories and then recapping the stories using their own words. We have become experts at noticing the story sequence, main characters, setting, and main events in each story. Since the start of winter, our stories have been all about the seasons changing and the many ways that animals and people prepare for winter. The girls have found it fascinating to learn the science behind the weather changes and why some animals need to migrate or hibernate in order to protect themselves. 5

She discussed the addictive nature of technological devices, the dangers of peer pressure and instant gratification and the subtle messages that chip away and eventually change our value system. Mrs. Zelcer empowered our mothers to model for children healthy safe use of technological devices. We also thank Rabbi Eric Goldman of TAG for opening the evening with introductory remarks.

🏠 IN-SERVICE FOR MOROS
