5TH 5TH GRADE HASCHOLAS GEMORAH

This past Sunday was a delightful and special day in YTT as our *choshuve* 5th graders were joined by their fathers, grandfathers (and even some great grandfathers!) for the very special occasion of starting to learn *gemorah*. Indeed it is a huge celebration, as the boys begin to delve into the intricacies of the *heilige Tanoim* and *Amoroim* with a sweetness and a zest that can be had nowhere else! Our *Mashgiach* Rabbi Tenenbaum opened the program by welcoming everyone and pointing out to the *talmidim* how everyone came out to participate in this celebration - because in truth no matter what one does, whether he is a simple layman, wealthy business man or retired *Zeidy*, all understand that "at the end of the day" the pleasure derived from a *blatt gemora* can be compared to no other! Even *Dovid Hamelech*, the wealthy king, proclaimed "Tov li toras picha me'afei zahav va'chesev!"

Continuing on that very same theme, the *Rosh Hakollel*, our *Rosh Vaad Hachinuch*, *Rav Dovid Zucker Shlit"a* dazzled the boys and guests with an array of stories and *vertlach* that portray the sweetness of *Torah* and how one can attain it. "Only if we keep our *neshamos* healthy and pure can we merit to taste the sweetness of *torah* in its fullest! Otherwise, it can even taste bitter *chas v'shalom!*"

The boys then sang a beautiful rendition of "V'zakeini l'gadel..." They were spontaneously joined by the many in attendance, who were simply swept away in the emotion of the moment.

Rabbi Muller began by saying he was worried to say much, as not to spoil



the beautiful words and song already expressed (and it was already quite late too)! "Tzadikim would say that after a whole month of *Yomim Tovim* it is hard to go into the winter.... What keeps us going? We see afar the little lights of *Chanukah* and that warms us and keeps warm and fresh... You boys don't need to wait for *Kislev* as you have today received the light of *Torah* in your very hands!"

The boys were then called up to get their gemorahs (and a sweet bar of chocolate!). The gemorahs were graciously dedicated by the Polstein Family in honor of the boys and the great milestone they have reached, and by the Mermelstein Family *Iz"n R' Chaim Aryeh ben Alexander*. Rabbi Muller concluded the program by *bentching* all that the learning of *Torah* should continuously inspire the boys to become *talmidei chachomim gedolim* and we should all come together again by their *siyum hashas*!


Jr SHABBATON IS COMING

Below are some comments:





- *More about what's going on every week, not only month*
