- Fill out the information and click Register. Add one child (**you will have the option to add more children at a later point**) Click Save.
- Please consent to receive emails from PTC Wizard (They will email the schedules and any notifications).
- To add more than one child, Click Account Settings and add all your children.
- To sync your conference schedules with your google calendar click the check box next to the calendar.

Now you are ready to schedule your conferences.

Please follow the steps below:

- Click the Add Meeting button.
- Click JDBY Conferences December 2019.

- You will then see all the teachers listed. **Important: There are two conference days, December 4 and December 11. Please make sure you have selected the conference day of your choice.**

- Once you have selected all the teachers you would like to schedule meetings with, click Continue. (The teachers are listed in alphabetical order, except for the Nursery, Kindergarten and select 1st grade classes which are listed at the end.)
 - Helpful Hint: To find names of teachers or grade levels press control+f and search.
- Choose the times available for each teacher (the teachers are listed on top of the column)
- If you have more than one child, the system will ask you which child this is for, after you choose a time.
- Choose all the meetings and then click Continue.

Scholarship Tax Credit

FACT OR FICTION?

I DON'T PAY IL INCOME TAX. I GET A REFUND EVERY YEAR.

FICTION. Virtually everyone pays income taxes. Almost all employees have state taxes withheld from their paychecks by their employers, and the refund is typically due to withholding more than your tax liability. An STC donation could eliminate your liability, which means all your withholdings could then be refunded.

MY LIABILITY IS SO LOW IT DOESN'T EVEN MAKE A DIFFERENCE.

FICTION. Every individual donation makes a difference, and when individual donations combine together, the impact can be HUGE.

THE WHOLE PROGRAM ISN'T RELEVANT TO ME BECAUSE I MAKE TOO MUCH MONEY TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR STC.

FICTION. There are two distinct aspects to the STC program: those who are eligible to receive scholarships, and those who make donations to fund these scholarships. Anyone who pays taxes to IL is eligible to make an STC donation, regardless of income and regardless of whether you're eligible to receive an STC scholarship.

I CAN'T DONATE BECAUSE MY KID(S) RECEIVED A SCHOLARSHIP.

FICTION. Many families who have received a scholarship (or multiple scholarships!) have also made STC donations. This is actually a great way to show appreciation for the program and help others benefit in the same way.

MY DONOR ADVISED FUND CAN'T MAKE AN STC DONATION.

FACT. Unfortunately donor advised funds can't make STC donations.



MY STC DONATION CAN COME FROM MY MAASER.

FACT. Rabbi Shmuel Fuerst, Rabbi Yona Reiss and many other *Poskim pasken* that 100% of an STC donation can count as *maaser*, even though you receive 75% back as a tax credit.

IN TERMS OF TAXES, I'M BETTER OFF MAKING A REGULAR DONATION.

FICTION. A 75% IL tax credit will always be a greater dollar amount than a regular charitable donation deduction on your taxes for the same dollar donation. The largest tax benefit you can possibly receive from a charitable donation deduction on your federal taxes is 37%. In fact, many people actually receive 0% tax benefit from their regular charitable donations because they don't itemize.

I CAN WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE ON 11/30 TO DECIDE.

FICTION. A Letter ID from mytax.illinois.gov can take up to two weeks to arrive in the mail, and you can't donate without using that Letter ID to create an account.

TUITION COST DOESN'T GET REDUCED SIGNIFICANTLY IF A STUDENT RECEIVES A SCHOLARSHIP.

FICTION. Every parent whose child receives an STC scholarship will pay less tuition. Full tuition at JDBY-YTT is currently \$13,500. If a student receives an STC scholarship for the maximum amount of \$13,336.64, the tuition is reduced to \$163.36 FOR THE YEAR for that student. This means life-changing savings for families of students receiving scholarships. We have over 700 eligible students, and over 500 of them are eligible to receive \$13,336.64. Your donation will help drastically reduce tuition for the next student in line to receive a scholarship.

I HAVE TO DO A BIG LUMP DONATION ALL AT ONCE.

FICTION. You can make as many STC donations as you'd like over the course of the year.


