ROCHEL IMEINU'S YAHRZEIT

At JDBY we learn from and try to emulate the מעשים טובים and מדות of רחל אמנו. On י"א חשוון, the Yahrzeit of רחל אמנו, three assemblies were held. First and second grade listened attentively as Morah Atlas told the story of רחל אמנו giving over the סמנים in detail. The girls imagined together how it would feel to be in her place. The second grade classes then sang a special song about רחל אמנו, with great motions. The third, fourth and fifth grades participated in an assembly with Morah Wainhaus. The fifth grade performed תפילת חנה with motions. The fourth grade sang a beautiful song about רחל אמנו. The third grade shared an English version of the song, "אודה לך די" that stresses the importance of constantly feeling and expressing הכרת הטוב. Mrs. Kaufman ran a very rich program for the Junior High. The girls were addressed by Mrs. Kaufman, Mrs. Homnick, Mrs. Mandelbaum and Mrs. Roberts. Each Morah shared a different perspective of what we can learn from רחל אמנו. The girls also watched a short clip from the "nationwide" video and concluded with singing נשמע קול ברמה.

Over the course of two days, all of the students at JDBY in grades K-8 practiced bus safety evacuation techniques. On Tuesday, an assembly was held for Kindergarten through eighth grade, in which bus decorum and rules were reviewed by Mrs. Homnick, Mrs. R. Wechsler and Mrs. Wainhaus. On Wednesday, each bus number was called and the girls came quickly and quietly to the primary grade hallway. After Mrs. R. Wechsler cautioned the girls not to be fearful about the practice and gave a few directions, the girls stood up and quietly loaded the bus one at a time. Older girls, seated in the last few rows of each bus, were asked to open the emergency door exit hatch at the rear of the bus. The girls exited row by row in a quiet, orderly manner. As each girl got to the back of the bus, she sat at the hatch door and slid out in an orderly fashion. The older girls helped the younger girls and directed them to the "safe holding area" away from the bus. Our parent body would have been very proud to watch the girls throughout the afternoon drill. 


