



Scholarship Tax Credit (STC) Weekly Update:

The scholarship tax credit program will positively affect every JDBY-YTT parent. If you have not yet completed these 3 quick steps, please do so now.

WHAT YOU NEED TO DO NOW

- Every single family should donate something to ensure the long-term success of this program even if you will also be a recipient. If you pay IL state taxes, please create a MyTax Account, it will only take 2 minutes – instructions can be found on our website – jdbyytt.org/stc
- Get a copy of your 2016 tax returns and an estimate of your anticipated income for 2017 and 2018.
- As we prepare for the Scholarship Tax Credit program we need essential information to help us plan properly. Please fill out a [short 5 question form](#) to assist us in gathering this information in a quick and efficient way. The form can be accessed from jdbyytt.org/stc or please contact the Business Office for a copy.

Scholarship Tax Credit Program FAQs

AM I ELIGIBLE FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

- You are eligible for a scholarship and have a chance to pay MUCH lower tuition for the 2018-19 school year for any children in grades K-12 in a recognized school in the state of Illinois, if your household AGI (Adjusted Gross Income) on your 2016 Federal income tax return doesn't exceed 300% of the federal poverty line (FPL). Use the chart below for reference. AGI excludes certain tax-exempt income, such as parsonage.

HOW MUCH OF A SCHOLARSHIP CAN I GET?

- Scholarships will be awarded per child
- If the household AGI is:
 - Up to 185% of FPL - the lesser of full tuition plus fees or \$12,973.
 - Between 185% - 250% of FPL - the lesser of 75% of tuition and fees or \$9,729.75
 - Between 250% - 300% of FPL - the lesser of 50% of tuition and fees or \$6,486.50

HOW CAN I APPLY?

- Applications will be available online only on January 24th, 2018. We anticipate a short application window, as the funds will only be available on a first come first serve basis. It is therefore imperative to be fully prepared and ready to act. We will update you with clear instructions on how and where to apply in advance of the application dates.


