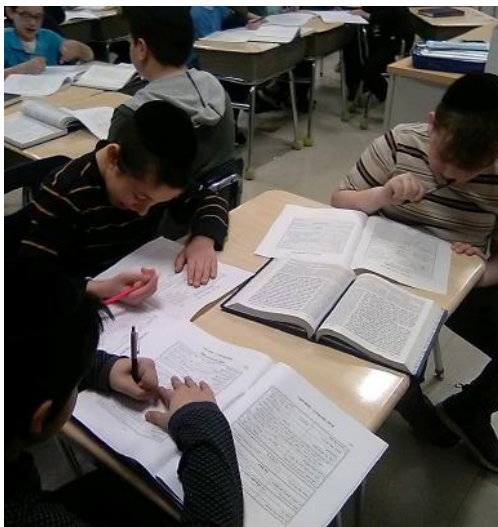

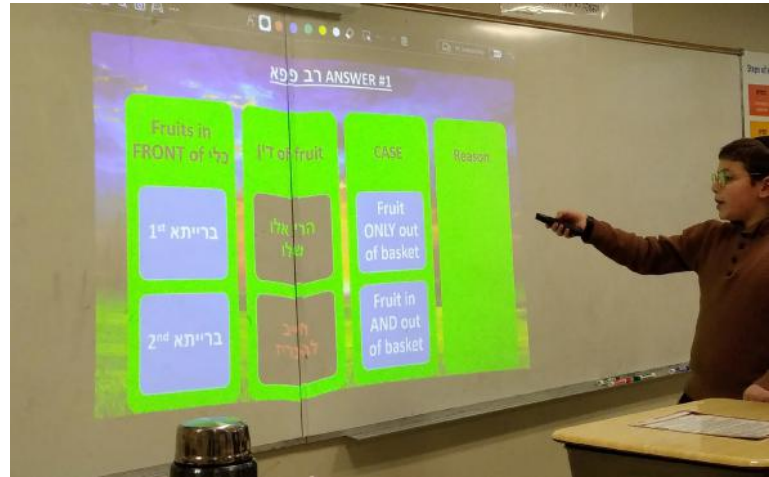
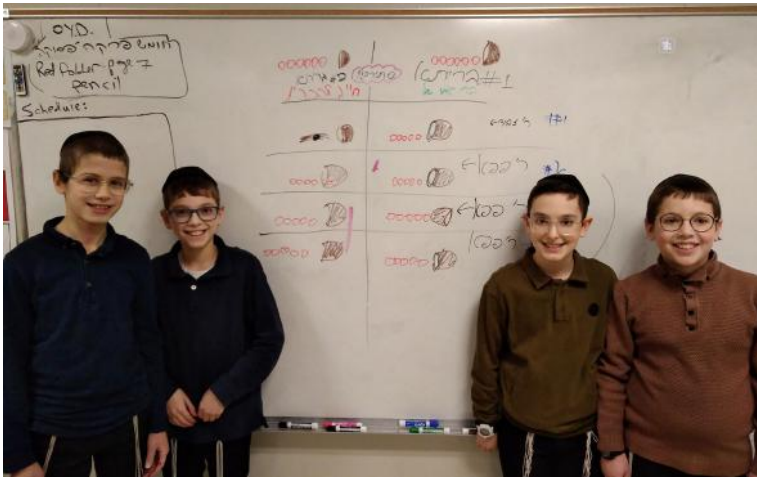
6TH 6TH GRADE SIYUM

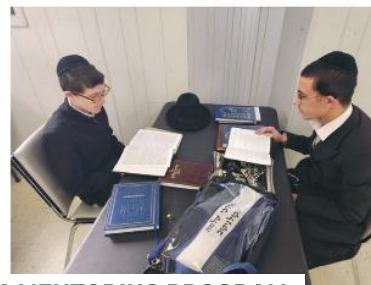

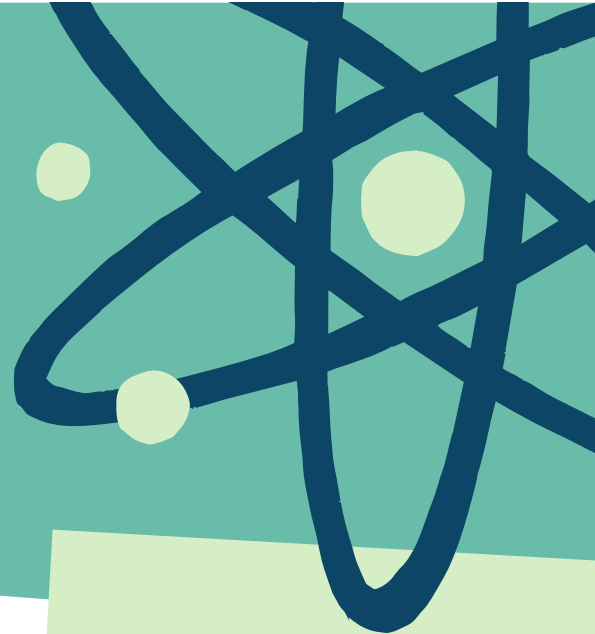
