## 4TH PARSHA PEARLS



## 🏠 3RD AND 4TH GRADE WALDER SCIENCE PRESENTATION

Walder Science introduced a new concept – siphons -to our 3rd and 4th graders. A siphon uses a combination of atmospheric pressure and gravity to carry liquids (usually water) from a high location to a lower location without the use of a pump. This can occur even if a part of the flow through the hose takes the liquid uphill. The students used straws and tubing to make their siphons. They also learned how a toilet flushes and rids the contents in the toilet bowl through a siphoning mechanism. To mimic a functioning toilet, students made a “toilet cup” that completely drains after being sufficiently filled.



## 🏠 7TH AND 8TH GRADE WALDER SCIENCE PRESENTATION

This week, Walder Science brought many experiments involving magnets to our 7th and 8th graders. They learned that scientists think that the center of the Earth is made of solid and liquid iron. It is this iron core that gives the Earth its magnetic field and why a compass works the way it does. This magnetic field (together with the solar wind) is responsible for the beautiful colors in the sky around the North Pole (Northern lights/Aurora Borealis). After the students saw how a compass works and is affected by magnetic fields, they made their own working compass. Students experimented with a bar magnet and iron filings. Using these items they saw the magnetic field lines of a bar magnet. They investigated how like poles repel and unlike poles attract. They also made their own electro-magnets and saw how an iron nail wrapped around with insulated wire becomes magnetic when electricity is passed through the wire.




## 🏠 5TH AND 6TH GRADE WALDER SCIENCE PRESENTATION

Walder Science really engaged the 5th and 6th graders with hands-on experiments involving current electricity. They learned that a basic electric circuit must have a power source, wires and some type of a resistor (e.g. light bulb, motor). They built their own circuits and discovered that an LED light will only allow the electricity to flow in one direction. They also experimented by changing the connections on a motor and noticed that it spun in opposite directions when the wires were reversed. Different materials were also explored to see which were good conductors of electricity and which were not.

What a special day for our "Teacher of the Day", Chava Hartman. Not only was it her birthday, but also her baby brother's bris! Chava captivated our class with a lesson on GCF (greatest common factor).



### 3<sup>RD</sup> TERRIFIC TRIP

Ms. Goldsmith and Mrs. Muschel's classes each read 3,000 books so far this year. To celebrate, they walked to the Antonia Spitzer Jewish Library and learned all about how our Jewish Library is run! Thank you, Mrs. Schneider, for answering all of our questions and showing us around!

Mrs. Berger's sixth grade worked hard on their fraction cookbooks. This assignment was the culmination of their unit on fractions and a highlight of the year for the students. Using six recipes of their choice, the girls had to do mathematical computations such as doubling, tripling and halving the recipes. They each created a unique cookbook with these recipes. Extra points were awarded for creativity. The girls were very excited about this project and used their artistic talents as well as math knowledge. The final products were outstanding both in their originality and accuracy! Cooking and baking are just two examples of some of the practical uses of fractions in everyday life and the girls have gained a new appreciation for the math lessons they have learned this year.

On behalf of the hundreds of families in need whom we serve, we'd like to thank JDBY for raising funds on behalf of Chicago Chesed Fund.


Those funds will go directly to Jewish families in our own community, and help them feed and clothe their children and keep a roof over their heads.
