On Friday morning, a beautiful kabolas ponim was held in honor of a visit from the Sassover Rebbe of Eretz Yisroel. The boys all lined up to greet the Rebbe with utmost kavod and the Rebbe warmly greeted each boy (in English!). After singing a few hartzege nigunnim with the Rebbe, he then spoke to the older grades about what it means to connect with people of our previous generation who they in turn were connected to the elders of their generation. "It is the mesoras hatorah from Rebbe to talmid that makes Klal Yisroel so unique and special". The Rebbe then spoke about the importance of shemiras hapeh and how careful one must be to ensure that what comes out of his mouth is proper. "We only have one mouth for both torah and tefilah - and mundane things, hence we must make sure it remains clean." Each boy had a chance to personally get a bracha and treat from the Rebbe and then many boys grouped around the Rebbe to further discuss what he spoke about. The boys really connected with him - and from what we heard from the Rebbe's host R' Yehoshua Ray - the Rebbe too really enjoyed his visit to YTT!



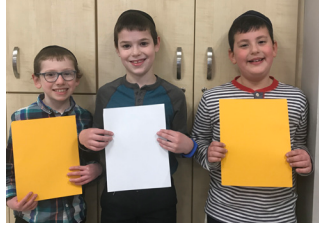
🏠 VISIT FROM THE SCRANTON ROSH HAYESHIVA

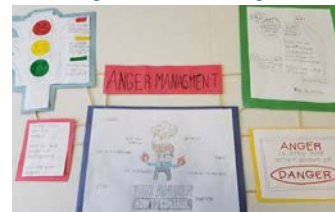
8TH ATT TORAH BOWL WINNERS

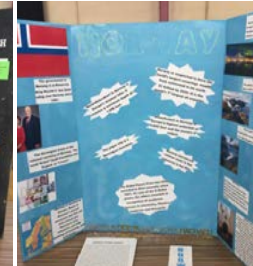
TORAH BOWL
