

The כמוך program made me very aware of other girls around me who didn't have as many friends and weren't part of what was going on. Thank you so much for bringing the כמוך program to our school.

I really benefited from the כמוך program this year. One of our class focus was not to speak about people during morning recess. I really felt that it spread to the rest of the day and really helped me.




Registration for the 2022-23 school year is open. Registration is required for both newly accepted applicants and continuing students, and is separate from the application progress.
