CHALLENGING CHANGES

Change is usually a challenge. As the first grade boys continue to adjust to our new school, they participated in an activity that helped anchor them. The class created a Venn Diagram is an illustration of the relationships between objects that have similarities and differences. The boys wrote details that analyzed how the old school and the new school were different (in overlapping circles on a diagram). The inner overlapping circle contained how both schools are alike. They will next organize and write their thoughts

about the new school in written composition.

הרבים, they are allowed to carry weapons, such as sticks to protect themselves. To help illustrate, two boys showed us what it would look like when the עדים traveled, protecting themselves. We definitely don't want to start up with them!

RAISE THE TORCH

While learning the משנה detailing the method בית דין used to publicize ראש חדש, Rabbi Borenstein's third grade class acted it out. In the times of the בית דין הגדול, long poles with materials that burned well were lit



on top of mountains, and waved a certain way. We lit our own pole, and the תלמידים told Rebbe where to wave the pole. Thank you Rabbi Kadin for helping us light the fire.

6R BIKE TRIP

After a very long wait, Rabbi Rosenberg's sixth grade went on their bike trip, earned from

collecting the most money from the Pushka Campaign at the start of the school year. Before they went, Rabbi Simkin spoke with them about "The rules of the road," which included safety and proper bike etiquette. Afterwards, Rabbi Simkin did some stretches with the תלמידים so they




would be better prepared. In the end the תלמידים did a beautiful job following their instructions




Ms. Daytz's and Mrs. London's 4th grade classes finally had the culminating activity to conclude many different lessons learned on the science of finding the perfect Bubble Juice. We started this unit with learning about atoms, chemical bonds, polymers, and measurement equivalents then moved on to using miter boxes, saws, and drills in the quest for making the perfect huge bubble sticks. The boys were exposed to the research process and then putting it to use in real-life activities. We used Dawn, powdered polymers, corn syrup, water and glycerin in different quantities to try to find which recipe is the best. Some of our bubbles were more than 15 feet long! We observed how light is diffused through bubbles, and how shadows showed beautiful rainbow colors. All of this learning was student centered, and didn't come from the teachers. The boys worked in groups and had to problem solve as problems arose. Thank you to many parents for joining us and helping keep everyone on track.
